General:

First Quarter of 2024 was very productive:

- The first quarter of 2024 was as busy as ever. As winter has a grip on us, we utilize this time for classroom and indoor training where possible.
- A PPE review with FDOG's
- SCBA review that had practical buddy breathing and bottle changing scenarios
- Decon FDOG and decon pail were reviewed.
- Captain/TO Ed Scott led us through new roads and developments in our first run areas.
- Module 2 First Aid/CPR ran twice this quarter wrapping up most of the members and certifying them.
- We toured/pre-planned Pintar, our largest commercial/industrial building and its unique features.
- Getting grassfire equipment ready for the spring, we reviewed tactics and equipment. UTV, blowers, water packs and brooms.
- Two members were sent to an EV awareness class hosted by Wellington County Training Officer Charles Hamilton, from there a power point presentation full of information was created and presented to both stations.
- The training division is working hard to prepare an action packed training year again.

FIRE PREVENTION (Chief Fire Prevention Officer Ted Michael)

Fire Inspections:

- 6 Large burn permit inspections
- 4 file searches
- Complaint follow up regarding smoke/co alarms activating, end of service life

- Weekly Inspections of builder’s sites to ensure compliance of firebreak lots and barrier free access for emergency services, I believe more preplan work should be completed for both arriving stations during an event.
- Tactical survey I created was given out, Station 10 Captains have modified it and are moving forward with implementation. It has been transferred into a fillable PDF.
- Conducted Preplan with Training of Pintar. Staff attended from both stations for the tour and to discuss the hazards etc
