Tanker 57 Request for Proposal 2020-01F

Recommendation

Be it resolved that Council hereby receive report number FD2020-04 "Tanker 57 Request for Proposal 2020-01F" for information;

And that Council accepts the bid from Fort Garry Fire Trucks (the lowest qualified bidder) for the tanker 57 replacement apparatus at a price of \$409,340.49 including the HST non-rebate portion.

Background

Council as part of the 2020 capital budget, approved the acquisition of a replacement apparatus for Tanker 57. The Fire Apparatus planning and design team met in early January to identify the apparatus concept and required features for our Tankers moving forward. An RFP was drafted and released to the public on January 28, 2020. The RFP closed on February 27, 2020. Of the eight (8) plan takers, we received two (2) bids. Both companies met the requirements of the RFP with Fort Garry Fire Trucks providing the lowest bid which was over \$14,500 lower. If awarded, the new apparatus will be delivered approximately 300 days following the pre-build meeting.

\$450,000 was budgeted for this project and with a proposal bid of \$409,340.49 it will fall far below the budgeted amount.

Conclusion

The Director of Fire & Emergency Services/Fire Chief recommends that Council accept the bid from Fort Garry Fire Trucks (the lowest acceptable bidder) for the acquisition of a new fire apparatus to replace the existing Tanker 57 for a price of \$409,340.49 including the HST non-rebate portion.
