## Subject Nestle Community Grant 2020

## Recommendation

**Be it resolved that** Council hereby receive report number F2020-08 *"Nestle Community Grant 2020"* for information;

**And that** Council direct staff to expend the 2020 community grant from Nestle in the following projects:

- 1. McMillan Park enhancement during holiday season \$11,750
- Let's Get Hillsburgh Growing beautification projects in consultation with staff \$11,750
- 3. Erin Lion's Club Christmas Parade \$1,500.

## Background

On April 18, 2017, Council passed Resolution #17-141 directing staff to provide Council annually with a recommended list of projects to be funded from the Voluntary Water Levy. On April 17, 2020 the Town received \$25,000 from Nestle. To comply with Council direction, staff reviewed community enhancements opportunities and recommend the following:

Project	Cost
1. McMillan Park enhancements during holiday season	\$11,750
2. Let's Get Hillsburgh Growing - beautification projects	\$11,750
<ol> <li>Erin Lion's Club – Christmas Parade (pending emergency measures are lifted by then)</li> </ol>	\$1,500
Total	\$25,000
